Mounzer Yassin-Kassab, MD



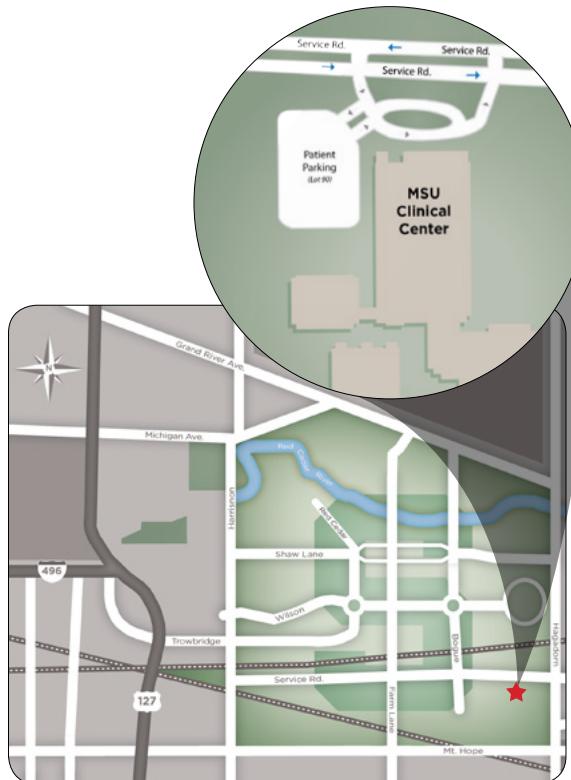
